Dr Akash Lavate introduced us to digitalization by explaining about intraoral scanners, the technology, use, format, accuracy and limitations. He elaborated that Intraoral scanners (IOSs) are devices that digitally reproduce the 3-dimensional (3D) geometry of the intraoral soft and hard tissues. IOSs project a light source, such as a laser or structured light, onto the surfaces being scanned and imaging sensors capture video or discrete images that are processed by the device's software to produce a 3D surface model Intraoral scanners are commonly used in orthodontics to create digital models of a patient's teeth. These models can be used to plan and design orthodontic treatments such as braces or clear aligners more accurately.

He further explained that by using intraoral scanners, it is possible for us to avoid distortion from the impression and gypsum materials.

The talk was followed by an animated discussion and demonstration.

The lecture was highly informative and innovative and well appreciated by all.
