

## NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMEMMORATIVE

### DAYS AND EVENTS

#### 1. INDEPENDENCE DAY

The independence day which is celebrated religiously throughout the country on 15<sup>th</sup> august every year, is celebrated in PDU Dental college with a parade by the students dressed in white, green and orange which starts at 7.30 am in the morning in the sport ground in front of the college building. A chief guest is invited every year and the national flag is hoisted by the principal, vice principal and the chief guest. This is followed by a speech by the principal and chief guest. Skits, dance etc. are performed by the students on patriotic theme. The ceremony is commenced by distribution of sweets to all.



#### 2. REPUBLIC DAY

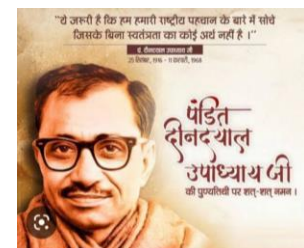


## 10. Orthodontics day

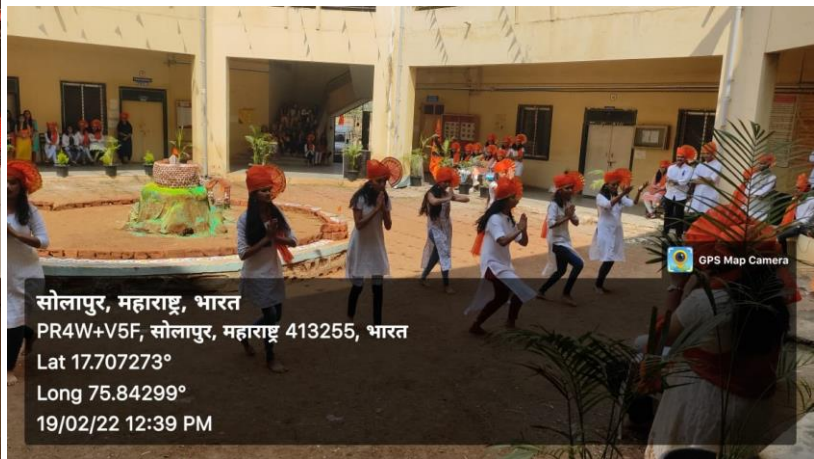
principal, vice principal all the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college lighting a lamp and speaking a few words on such a noble personality.

## 15. WOMEN'S DAY

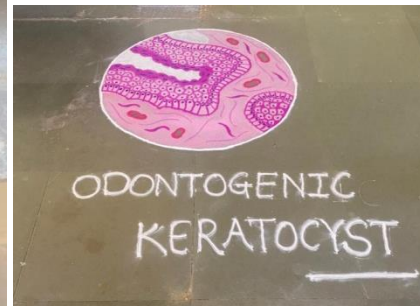
